IBA can help you succeed in business. We offer finance to either new or established businesses and professional support is available to you during all stages of your business development.

IBA wants more Indigenous Australians to own their own homes in the general housing market and in townships on community land. Our home loans are affordable and you may be eligible for an IBA home loan even if you have experienced difficulty gaining approval through other lenders.

Our competitive housing loans can also give Indigenous Australians the chance to own a home on Indigenous land.

IBA seeks out, assesses and invests in sound commercial ventures that encourage

and support active Indigenous participation. We can assist Indigenous groups and communities to participate in commercial enterprises through investments with us, the private sector or both.

We provide business support and mentoring to the Indigenous joint venture partners and economic development advice to groups and individuals.
