If you are an Indigenous Australian keen to enhance your skills through tertiary education, IBA's Scholarship Fund may be for you.

IBA's Scholarship Fund provides financial support for mature-age Indigenous students to achieve a tertiary educational qualification in business, financial, commercial or economic management.

Scholarships are intended for Indigenous Australians who:

- face financial barriers that might otherwise restrict them from gaining a tertiary qualification, and
- want to use their skills to contribute to their community's economic and financial development.

Are you eligible?

To be eligible for IBA's Scholarship Fund, you must be:

- of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- an Australian resident
- of mature-age (no younger than 19 years old, and have not finished secondary school within the past 18 months), and
- able to demonstrate support from your employer, community or an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander organisation to undertake study.

How do I apply?

Scholarship applications will be open in September of each year.
